Player Code of Conduct:

Show respect for team members. Support and praise each for both accomplishments and mistakes. Show respect for your opponent, coaches, and officials at all times.

Players will show respect at all times for coaches, other players, officials, spectators and the opposing team. They will show respect by their verbal and physical actions. There will team handshakes at the conclusion of the game were only positive comments will be exchanged with the opposing team and teammates.

Any verbal or physical abuse of teammates, opposing players, coaches, or officials will result in not only the ejection of the game for that player, but possible expulsion from the league. There is zero tolerance for such actions.

Accept the decisions of game officials.

Throwing the ball in a fit of temper is grounds for immediate ejection from the game. During league play, such action may result in suspension from future games at the discretion of the coaches.

Show respect for public property and equipment.

Any abuse of league equipment is grounds for suspension from one or more games at the discretion of the coaches and board of directors. Equipment is to be used in game or practices only. Any player found guilty of breaking or damaging league equipment or using league equipment to damage game or practice facilities will be required to reimburse the league for the damaged equipment and any additional expenses that the league may incur based on the players actions. Players will be suspended from play until reimbursement is received. Additional discipline may be result including expulsion from the league based on board of directors decision.

Any player accused of damaging any facilities that Hilton Select Basketball is playing at will be suspended from league participation pending investigation into the matter. In the event that the player is found guilty of damage, the player and his family will be responsible for any monetary damages incurred at the facility. The player involved status in the league will be determined by the board of director's. All board decisions in such matters are final.
